VACATION TIME IS COMING UP...

With RV's, trailers, boats and such around the neighborhood.

Keep in mind that RV's are to be stored out of sight, except for 72 hours to pack in preparation for a trip and an additional 72 hours to unpack and get it back to storage. This includes parking on the street.

The Board has determined, it was the intension of our founding fathers and the majority of current homeowners that RV's, trailers (both travel and commercial), oversized commercial vehicles, boats and various other recreational vehicles are to be stored out of the Village at off-site storage locations. This also applies to parking on the street. Unlicensed and/or inoperable vehicles may not be parked either on ones property or on the street.

If you are wanting to send in a formal complaint regarding an RV parked in your neighborhood, please allow the owner the 72 hours or 3 days allotted before writing a letter to the Board.
